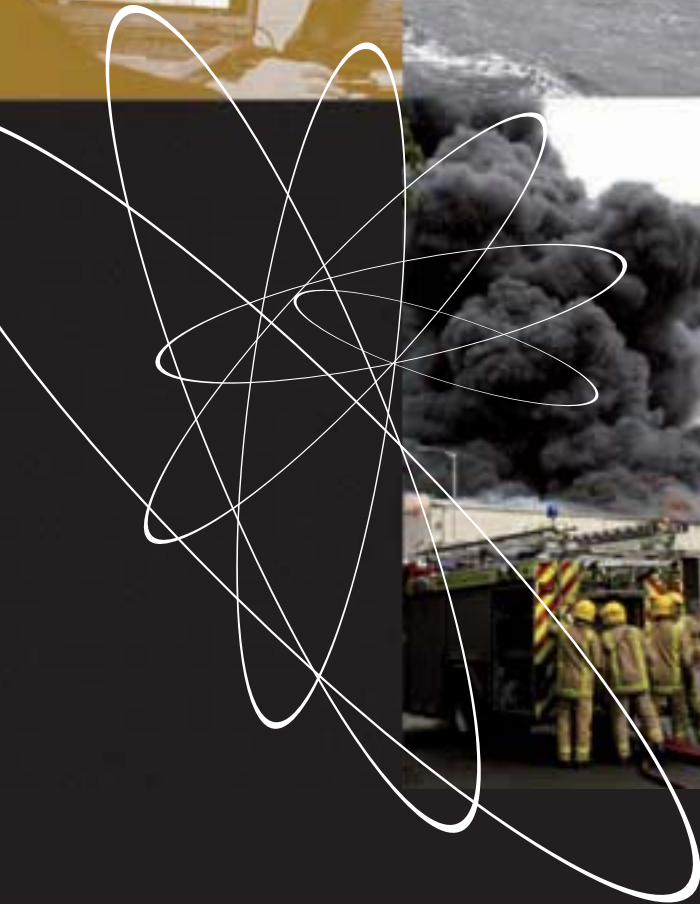
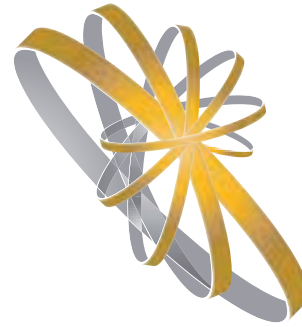

Multi Agency Civil Command Team Training

SELEX Systems Integration is working with the Emergency Planning College (EPC) to deliver the only UK Cabinet Office accredited Multi-agency Civil Command Team Training to Customers around the world. Delivered under the title Gold Standard, this training enables effective management of major emergencies and events, and meets the statutory requirements laid down in the Civil Contingencies Act 2004.



Gold Standard represents a step change in the UK capability for the provision of effective management of major emergencies and events. The training is based around a constructive simulation that stimulates Gold Command teams working in their normal environments with their local commanders driving the simulation.

It uses a combination of people, process and technology to provide a flexible training capability focused at providing Strategic "Gold" Commanders with a safe, stimulating, challenging and enjoyable learning environment through a specific exercise tailored to their assets, procedures and plans, geographical location and specific identified area risks.

The use of simulation provides a level of fidelity and data capture not previously possible, enabling the detailed analysis of outcomes. Realistic, scalable training is achieved without the significant expense of holding manpower intensive live exercises and the use of scarce front line resources.

A key component of the Civil Contingencies Secretariat, the EPC, based at Easingwold near York, is the UK's National Centre of Excellence for emergency planning and management, delivering multi-agency doctrine and training to support UK resilience.

Working in partnership with the EPC, training can be tailored for single or multi-agency Civil Command Team Training Exercises and delivered at locations specified by the Customer or at the EPC.

A wide range of scenarios are available, including;

- Floods
- Major Environmental Contamination
- Fire and Explosion
- Human Pandemic.

The training objectives for each course are tailored for each customer and have included:

- Exercising the strategic decision making capabilities of the Strategic Command Gold team
- Exercising the processes and procedures identified for mass casualty events
- Testing the resilience plans developed for the geographical area
- Testing the communication plans, both internally and externally, for major incidents.

Detailed models represent, in a realistic way, how the events for each scenario unfold and the resulting consequences.

Additional training options are also available to support individual and team development prior to a full Multi-agency Civil Command Team Training event. Training is available in the UK and internationally and complete systems can be developed and supplied to meet long term training needs anywhere in the world.
